

Fish Olympics

1. Introductions
2. Tell story of the dirty bedroom. Tie it into how hard it is to clean up water once it's really dirty.
3. Divide class into 2 groups - 1 with 5 fishermen (or about 20% of the class) and 1 with the rest of the class. Evenly divide 2nd group into 5 groups - 4 with some type of contaminated fish and 1 with healthy fish

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7. Discuss warning signs being posted at the lake
8. Ask activity ending questions
9. If time permits, play the entire activity again

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4. Fish have to stay in the lake (roped off area). Fishermen will be catching them (playing tag) and taking them back to the boat (2nd roped off area)
5. Talk with class about fishing limits. Blow whistle and let fishing begin
6. After fishermen have caught their limit and stored them in the boat, gather entire class together and have fishermen match up with their catch. Unveil each catch to discern whether it's healthy or contaminated

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10. Have fishermen return vest
11. Have students return fish
12. Hand out "Tommy Trout, Fish Detective" coloring book
13. Thank everyone for participating, compliment behavior and answer any questions the children may still have
14. Re-position ropes if necessary
